

Visual Effects and Motion Graphics Portfolio Requirements for Bachelor of Science

Upon completion of Portfolio Presentation, students must have a completed demo reel uploaded on Career Services website (<http://ai.ourstudentportfolios.com/fortlauderdale>), as well as a personal website that includes resume, digital stills, and high-quality demo reel (a link to the reel is acceptable).

The Demo Reel **MUST** have, at *minimum*:

- Opening motion graphics logo demonstrating design, compositing and animation skills
- Two 15-25 second motion graphics shots
 - Examples include animated logos, show openings, commercials, kinematic type
- Two 10-20 second compositing shots with shot buildups/breakdowns
 - Examples include rotoscoping, chroma keying, motion tracking, color correction, morphing
- One 3D set extension
- Two matte paintings in motion, with buildups/breakdowns

In addition to the Demo Reel, student must have professional identity:

- Resume
- Business cards
- Professional email address

Students will have three quarters to build final portfolio

- Portfolio Preparation DIG4951C
 - Storyboards, previsualization, personal identity design, compilation of existing shots, timeline for new shot productions (including scheduling of any green screen usage)
- Portfolio Development DIG4952C
 - Continue progress on new shots, refine existing shots
 - Student should be 75% completed with reel by Week 11
- Portfolio Presentation DIG4958C
 - Completion of all shots
 - Edited (with audio) final movie by MIDTERM Week 5
 - Uploaded hi-res demo reel on required websites
